

### **RHEOLAU**

- 1. Adnabyddir y Gymdeithas fel "Sioe Amaethyddol a Chymdeithas Gŵn Llyn ac Eifionydd".
- Bydd y Gymdeithas yn cynnwys Swyddogion Mygedol, pwyllgor o Weinyddwyr ac Aelodau. Lleiafswm tâl aelodaeth fydd £5 y flwyddyn, i fod yn daladwy cyn Hydref 1af bob blwyddyn.

Breintiau aelodaeth fel a ganlyn:

- (a) Bathodyn aelod
- (b) Tâl Ymgeision llai yn yr adrannau hynny a nodir yn y rhestr wobrau
- (c) Rhan mewn penderfynu polisi'r Gymdeithas yn y Cyfarfod Cyhoeddus Blynyddol
- (d) Hawl i gopïau o Gyhoeddiadau'r Gymdeithas, e.e. Rhestr Dosbarthiadau a Gwobrau, a'r Adroddiad Blynyddol.

Tâl Is-lywydd - £10, un Bathodyn, un Tocyn Rhad

- 3. Rhaid i bob anifail yn yr adran Da Byw fod yn eiddo i'r Arddangoswr. Bydd hawl gan y Pwyllgor ofyn am brawf perchnogaeth. Bydd unrhyw doriad ar y rheol hon yn golygu cosb i'r Arddangoswr, gall hyd yn oed olygu rhwystro'r arddangoswr rhag cymeryd rhan mewn unrhyw Sioe o eiddo'r Pwyllgor yn y dyfodol. Ni fydd y Pwyllgor, unrhyw Swyddog, na Beirniad yn atebol i unrhyw ddatganiad a wneir ynglyn a'r rheol hon.
- 4. Cyfrifoldeb yr Arddangoswr yn unig fydd ei eiddo. Ni ddelir y Pwyllgor, Swyddogion, Beirniaid na Stiwardiaid yn gyfrifol am unrhyw ddifrod, colled, na niwed i anifail, eiddo a.y.y.b., pru'n ai'n ganlyniad i ddamwain neu diofalwch.
- 5. Penodir pob Beirniad gan y Pwyllgor a'u penderfyniadau hwy fydd yn sefyll ym mhob achos. Bydd hawl gan Feirniaid i atal gwobr os nad yw yn ei farn ef / hi yn cyrraedd y safon. Os, mewn unrhyw achlysur y bydd rhif y ceisiadau yn llai na nifer y gwobrau, yna, fe atelir y wobr gyntaf, onibai yr argymhellir yn wahanol gan y Beirniad.
- 6. Ni chanietir unrhyw berson arwahan i'r Beirniaid, Stiwardiaid, Swyddogion a phersonau yn gyfrifol am stoc yn y cylch beirniadu, ac nid oes hawl gan unrhyw berson ymgymeryd â swydd Stiward mewn dosbarth y mae'n ymddangos ynddo. Symudir unrhyw berson fydd yn ymyryd a'r Beirniaid oddi ar y cae.
- 7. Rhaid i'r ceisiadau fod yn nwylo'r Ysgrifennydd erbyn: ceffylau:- 15 Ebrill 2023; adran coginio a crefft:- Ebrill 22ain 2023 a phob adran arall:- 29 Ebrill 2023. Rhaid i bob cais fod ar y ffurflenni swyddogol gyda'r tâl ymgeisio daladwy. Rhaid croesi sieciau a.y.y.b. a'u gwneud yn daladwy i "Gymdeithas Amaethyddol Llyn a'r Cylch".

- 8. Rhaid i bob anifail yn yr adrannau Da Byw fod ar y Cae Sioe o leiaf hanner awr cyn y beirniadu. Rhaid i bob anifail aros ar y cae tan 3.30 y prynhawn. Rhaid llwyfannu pob ymgais yn yr adrannau Ffwr a Phlu, Coginio a Gwaith Llaw erbyn 9.30 y bore. Bydd torri y rheol hon yn golygu fforffedu gwobrau.
- 9. Dylid cyflwyno pob cwyn a phrotest yn ysgrifenedig i'r Ysgrifennydd awr cyn diwedd y sioe ynghyd a blaendâl o £30. Cysidrir pob cwyn gan y Beirniad ac/neu y Pwyllgor cyn diwedd y sioe. Os bydd unrhyw gwynion heb eu setlo, yna fe trafodir yng nghyfarfod nesa'r Pwyllgor. Os gwrthodir unrhyw gwyn yna fforffedir'r y blaendâl.
- 10. Bydd ennillydd pob cwpan yn gyfrifol am eu dychwelyd 11 mis wedi'r sioe olaf, a gwneir cytundeb ysgrifenedig i hynny.
- 11. Gadewir un person sy'n gyfrifol am anifail / arddangosfa neu set o arddangosfeydd yn yr adran ddefaid i mewn am ddim ynghyd ag un Tocyn Rhad am bob 4 ymgais ychwanegol yn yr adran ddefaid. Yn yr adrannau eraill, bydd tâl ymgeisio o £2 a throsodd yn roi hawl i ymgeisydd i un Tocyn Mynediad Rhad.
- 12. Ni ddelir y Pwyllgor, Swyddogion, Beirniad na Stiwardiaid yn gyfrifol am unrhyw ddifrod, niwed neu golled i wyliwyr neu unrhyw berson arall fydd ar y cae sioe ar ddiwrnod y Sioe, waeth sut y cyflawnwyd y ddifrod, niwed neu golled.
  - Yn ogystal, ni dderbynir cyfrifoldeb am golled na niwed i fodur, prun ai'n cyrraedd, gadael neu wedi ei barcio ar y Cae Sioe.
- 13. Pe bai cyfanswm y derbyniadau yn llai na chyfanswm treuliau, bydd hawl gan y Pwyllgor i dynnu cyfran gyfartal, neu cymeryd gwobr yn gyfan er mwyn gwneud iawn am y golled.
- 14. Bydd yn rhaid i bob arddangosiad yn yr Adran wartheg gael passport cyfredol neu ddogfen adnabod i'w gyflwyno i'r Ysgrifennydd Adran ar y diwrnod er mwyn gallu hysbysu BCMS o'r symudiad i'r sioe ac oddi yno.
- 15. Bydd yn rhaid i bob arddangoswr yn yr Adran Ddefaid lenwir ffurflenni symud pwrpasol gan yr Adran Safonau masnach er mwyn dod ar y cae, ac un arall i fynd oddi ar y cae.
- 16. Disgwylir i bob cerbyd a gaiff fynediad i'r adrannau, da byw gydymffurfio a rheolau galweithdra.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- The Society shall be known as the "Lleyn and Eifionydd Agricultural Show and Canine Society". It's objects shall be the promotion of good stock and the encouragement of improvement in all branches of Agriculture.
- The Society shall consist of the Honorary Officials, a Committee of Management and Members. The minimum membership fee shall be £5 per annum, the fee being considered due and payable of the 1st of October in each year.

Privileges of membership are as follows:

- (a) Member's badge
- (b) Reduced entry fees in such sections as is shown in the Prize List
- (c) Participation in determining the Policy of the Society at the Annual General Meeting
- (d) Entitlement to copies of the Society's publications e.g. Schedule of Classes and Prizes and the Annual Report

Vice-President's Fee - £10, one badge, one complimentary ticket

The rights and privileges of a members shall be personal to himself / herself and are not transferable or transmissible

- 3. All exhibits in the Livestock Section must be the property of the exhibitor. The Committee shall have the right to call upon any exhibitor to prove such ownership. Infringement of this rule will entail forfeiture of all prizes won by the exhibitor at the Show in which the rule shall have been infringed, and it may also entail barring from future shows held by the Committee. Neither the Committee, nor any official, or judge, shall be held liable in respect of any statement made in pursuance of this rule, or in any attempt to enforce it.
- 4. All exhibits in whatever Section or Class, will be considered as being in the sole charge of the exhibitor. The Committee, or any official, or Judge, or any Steward acting for and on behalf of the Committee, shall not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury caused by or to any exhibit whether owing to accident, negligence or any other cause.
- 5. All Judges shall be appointed by the Committee and their decision shall be final in all cases. Any Judge may withhold any prize if, in his / her opinion, the exhibit does not attain the required standard of merit, and in the event of the entries in any class in which the total number of entries is less than the total number of prizes being offered the first prize money will be withheld, unless specifically recommended by the Judge.
  The Judges shall determine their awards solely by reference to the numbers affixed to
  - each exhibit and correspondingly with the number printed in the Catalogue. Only the signed awards of the Judges shall be accepted by the Show Committee as evidence that a prize has been awarded.

- 6. No person other than Judges, Stewards, Officials and persons in charge of stock shall be allowed in the Judging Ring and no person shall act as steward in any class in which he is an exhibitor. Any person interfering with any Judge shall be removed from the Showground and, if an exhibitor, shall forfeit any prizes otherwise due to him / her.
- 7. All entries must be in the hands of Secretaries by: horses:- 15th April 2023; cookery and handicraft section 22nd April 2023 and all other sections:- 29th April 2023. All entries must be on the Official Forms and accompanied by the appropriate entry fees. Cheques, monies and postal orders must be crossed and made payable to "Lleyn and District Agricultural Society".
- 8. All exhibits in the Livestock Sections must be on the Showground at least 30 minutes before judging is due to commence. All exhibits must remain on the Showground until 3.30 p.m. All entries in the Fur and Feather, Cookery and Handicraft Sections must be caged or staged by 9.30 a.m. and must not be removed until 4.30 p.m.
- 9. All protests and complaints must be delivered in writing to the Secretary one hour before the close of Show, together with a deposit of £30. Such objections will be considered by the Judges and/or Officials before the close of the show. If any objections or complaints remain unsettled, it shall be settled by the committee at their next meeting. If any complaint or objection be disallowed, the deposit shall be forfeited.
- 10. The winner of each cup shall be responsible for returning it to the committee at least 11 months after the last show, and shall give a written undertaking to that effect.
- 11. One person in charge of an exhibit or set of exhibits in the Sheep section shall be allowed in without charge, and a further one Complimentary ticket for every four exhibits in the Sheep section. In the other sections, an entry fee of £2 or over will entitle the exhibitor to one free admission ticket.
- 12. The committee, or any official, judge or stewards shall not be held liable for any loss, damage or injury to any spectator or any other person being on the Showground on the day of the show, however such damage, loss, or injury shall have been caused. Similarly, no responsibility is accepted by the Committee for any loss or damage to any vehicle while entering or leaving or parked on the showground.
- 13. Should the total receipts be less than the total expenditure, the committee shall have the power to deduct a proportionate percentage from, or to remit the whole of the prize money, sufficient to make up the deficiency.
- 14. Each entry in the cattle section must be accompanied by a current passport or COR document to be presented to the section secretary to allow notification of the movement to BCMS.
- Each exhibitor in the sheep section must complete the correct movement forms to be allowed onto the showground, and complete a return journey form for the trading standards.
- 16. All vehicles admitted onto the showground must comply with hygiene regulations.





#### **RHEOLAU / RULES**

#### DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don't travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not airconditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

#### Warning: if your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Regulations.

Right to refuse entries. Exhibitors / competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.

#### (A) WELSH PONIES AND COBS

The awarding of rosettes by The Gwynedd Welsh Pony Breeder's Association is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Awarding is confined to fully paid up members of the Association
- (2) Such members must display red armbands when exhibiting

#### (B) WELSH PONY AND COB SOCIETY

Classes 1 - 37 will be judged under the latest rules issued by the Welsh Pony and Cob Society, a copy of which will be on display in the Horse Secretary's caravan.

#### (C) CATTLE SECTION

For all exhibits, the name of the breeder, name of the animal, it's date of birth and herd book reference, name of sire and reference and name of dam and reference must be included on the Entry Form. All entries are subject to the following conditions under the Brucellosis (England and Wales) Order 1981 (as amended).

- 1. Premises to be used for accredited cattle must be cleared of stock and cleansed and disinfected before the day of use.
- 2. The isolation accommodation must be clearly marked.
- When sterilised milking units are provided at the Show, they must be suitably
  disinfected after milking each cow. If hand milking is practised the milker must
  disinfect his hands after milking each cow. Water and milking points should be clearly
  marked.
- 4. Only milk re-constituted from dried milk (as defined in article 10(5) of the Transit of Animals (Road and Rail Order 1975) may be fed to the calves, but a dam may be allowed to suckle her calf.
- 5. Animals which calve or show evidence of calving whilst at the showground must be placed in the approved isolation accommodation pending their possible early removal from the showground.
- 6. Where an animal calves at full term, and the owner arranges for a blood sample and a vaginal swab to be taken and examined at an approved laboratory, and the Rose Bengal Test (RBPT) and microscopic examination of a smear made from the vaginal swab are negative, the animal may return to the show lines at the discretion of the show secretary.
- 7. Where the animal calves prematurely or aborts the D.V.O. must be informed immediately. The animal must be returned home together with all other show animals from the same registered premises after a full range of samples (including if at all possible a placental smear) has been taken. The suspected animal must be isolated during transit.
- 8. No person (other than show officials, judges, marshals and the owner or his / her representative) shall be permitted to enter the Show ring during the period the animals are paraded.
- 9. Judges must wash and dry their hands before handling accredited stock in the Show ring and an adequate supply of clean water, disinfectant, soap and disposable towels should be provided for this purpose.
- 10. The Show organisers shall be responsible for complying with the above conditions.
- "Preferably, no cattle are to be exhibited if affected with Warble Fly". A condition
  of entry that they must be accompanied by a Certificate of Treatment will be strictly
  enforced.

#### (D) SHEEP SECTION

Separate pens will be available for accredited flocks of any breed. Appendix 2 to A.H.C. 84/30

#### MAFDI-VISNA ACCREDITED FLOCK SCHEME

Conditions for the Approval of Shows which provide separate sections for Accredited and Top-Supervised (S2)\* Scheme sheep.

- A plan must be submitted to the local D.V.O. with the proposed separate section for Accredited sheep clearly marked in red and the section for Top-Supervised (S2) marked in green.
- 2. There must be satisfactory separation of each category of Scheme sheep. If the premises are large it may be possible to have the approved section separated by a solid partition from the floor to the roof. If this cannot be done a stock-free area of 10 metres must be maintained between each category, i.e. between Accredited, Top-Supervised and Non-Scheme sheep. In open penning, at least 10 metres separation is required between each category of sheep in pens. At loading bays and in passages there must be at least 2 metres between different categories while sheep are moving.
- 3. M/V Scheme sheep must have a separate loading and unloading point which should be shown on the plan and their movement into, within and out of the show must be in accordance with the routes marked on the plan. Where passages to other sections exist, these should be sealed off by secure barriers.
- 4. If Scheme and Non-Scheme sheep are to be judged in the same class, the ring should be split to ensure adequate separation. Preferably Scheme sheep should be led by a halter or collar and there should be a 2 metre space between different categories. It is accepted that judges will need to pass between, and handle, different categories of sheep, but any examination such as mouthing should be carried out by the handler for the judge's inspection.
- 5. M/V Scheme sheep must at no time be allowed to come into contact with Non-Scheme sheep or sheep of a lower status. Accredited and Top-Supervised (S2) sheep must not be transported to or from shows together. Nor must they share transport with lower status or Non-Scheme.
- 6. There must be separate watering and feeding facilities for each category of Scheme sheep.
- 7. In order to gain admission to the designated Approved section of the show, all Scheme sheep must be accompanied by proof of stats. Accredited sheep must have a yellow MV 20B certificate and Top-Supervised (S2) sheep, a blue MV 20A certificate. Sheep with a red MV 20 certificate are not eligible for entry to the Approved section and must be classed as Non-Scheme sheep.
- 8. Show authorities shall be responsible for complying with the conditions.
  - **Reminder:** Show organisers are reminded that land to be used as a showground should be cleared of Non-Scheme sheep at least 30 days prior to the moving on of Scheme sheep.
- 9. The exhibition of sheep and goats from premises registered on the Temporary Scrapie Export Register, or are members of Category IV of the Sheep and Goat Health Scheme must be segregated under the rules of the above scheme. Approval must be obtained from the Divisional Veterinary Officer. Unproved land must not have been used on animals other than from registered premises for the previous 12 weeks. Segregation of sheep on the Scrapie Export Register or those monitored as Category IV of the

Sheep and Goats Health Scheme is required if pregnant or recently lambed sheep are present at the same Show.

\*Sheep requiring one further flock test to reach Accredited status. Animal Health Division IA (March 1984)

#### (G) JUNIOR COOKERY SECTION

Exhibitors must be aged 16 or under on the day of the Show, and date of birth must be stated on the entry form. Junior exhibitors may exhibit in all sections, junior or general. Winning entries in the Junior Section will be entered automatically in the General Section.

It is of the utmost importance that the Junior exhibits are the **exhibitor's own work throughout** with no adult assistance whatsoever.
