RHEOLAU

1. Adnabyddir y Gymdeithas fel "Sioe Amaethyddol a Chymdeithas Cwn Llyn ac Eifonydd"
2. Bydd y Gymdeithas yn cynnwys Swyddogion Meddygol, pwyllgor o weinyddwyr ac Aelodau. Lleiafswm tal aelodaeth fydd £5 y flwyddyn i fod yn daladwy cyn Hydref 1af bob blwyddyn. Breintiau aelodaeth fel a ganlyn:
 - a) Bathodyn aelod
 - b) Tal ymgeisio llai yn yr adrannau hynny a nodir yn y rhestr wobrau
 - c) Rhan mewn penderfynnu polisi'r Gymdeithas yn y Cyfarfod Cyhoeddus Blynnyddol
 - d) Hawl i gael copiau o gyhoeddiadau'r Gymdeithas megis rhestr dosbarthiadau a gwobrau a'r adroddiad blynnyddol.
 - e) Tal Is-Lywydd - £10, un bathocyn ac un tocyn rhad
3. Rhaid i bob anifail yn yr adran da byw fod yn eiddo i'r Arddangoswr. Bydd hawl gan y Pwyllgor ofyn am brawf perchnogaeth. Bydd unrhyw doriad ar y rheol hon yn golygu cosb i'r Arddangoswr, gall hyd yn oed olygu rhwystro'r arddangoswr rhag cymeryd rhan mewn unrhyw Sioe o eiddo'r Pwyllgor, unrhyw Swyddog, na Beirniad yn atbol i unrhyw ddatganiad a wneir ynglyn a'r rhoel hon
4. Cyfrifoldeb yr Arddangoswyr yn unig fydd ei eiddo. Ni ddeler y Pwyllgor, Swyddogion, Beirniaid na Stiwardiaid yn gyfrifol am unrhyw ddifrod, colled na niwed i anifail, eiddo a.y.y.b prun ai'n ganlyniad i ddamwain na diofalwch.
5. Penodir pob Beirniad gan y Pwyllgor a phenderfyniad y Beirniaid fydd yn sefyll ymhob achos. Bydd hawl gan Feirniaid i atal gwobr os nad yw ei farn ef/hi yn cyrraedd y safon. Os, mewn unrhyw achlysur y bydd rhif y ceisiadau yn llai na nifer y gwobrau, yna, fe atelir y wobr gyntaf, onibai yr argymhellir yn wahanol gan y Beirniad.
6. Ni chaniateir unrhyw berson arwahan i'r Beirniad, Stiwardiaid, Swyddogion a phersonau yn gyfrifol am stoc yn y cylch yn y cylch beirniadu, ac nid oes hawl gan unrhyw berson ymgymeryd a swydd Stiward mewn dosbarth y mae'n ymddangos ynddo. Symudir unrhyw berson fydd yn ymyryd a'r beirniaid oddi ar y cae.
7. Rhaid i'r ceisiadau fod yn nwylo'r Ysgrifennydd erbyn:-

Rhaid i bob cais fod ar y ffurflenni swyddogol gyda'r tal ymgeisio daladwy. Rhaid gwneud y sieciau yn daladwy i "Gymdeithas Amaethyddol Llyn ac Eifonydd". Gellir talu gyda BACS – manylion ar gael gan yr Ysgrifenyddion.
8. Rhaid i bob anifail yn yr adrannau Da Byw fod ar y Cae Sioe o leiaf hanner awr cyn y beirniadu. Rhaid i bob anifail aros ar y car tan 3.30pm. Rhaid llwyfannu pob ymgais yn yr adrannau Ffwr a Phlu, Coginio a Gwaith Llaw erbyn 9.30 y bora a'u gadael tan 3.30pm
9. Dylid cyflwyno pob cwyn a phrotest yn ysgrifenedig i'r Ysgrifennydd awr cyn diwedd y Sioe

ynghyd a blaendal o £30. Cysidrir pob cwpan gan y Beirniad ac/neu y Pwyllgor cyn diwedd y Sioe. Os bydd unrhyw gwynion heb eu setlo, yna fe drafodir yng nghyfarfod nesaf y Pwyllgor. Os gwrthodir unrhyw gwyn, ni fydd y blaen dal yn cael ei ad-dalu.

10. Bydd ennillydd pob cwpan yn gyfrifol am eu dychwelyd 11 mis wedi's Sioe olaf, a gwneir cytundeb ysgrifenedig i hynny.
11. Gadewir un person sy'n gyfrifol am anifail/arddangosfa neu set o arddangosfeydd yn yr adran gwartheg a ddefaid i mewn am ddim ynghyd ac un tocyn rhad am bob 4 ymgais ychwanegol yn yr adran ddefaid. Yn yr adrannau eraill, ac eithro cwn a ceffylau, bydd tal ymgeisio o £2 neu ragor yn rhoi hawl i'r ymgeisydd gael un tocyn mynediad rhad. Bydd arddangoswyr cwn yn ymgeisio ar y diwrnod. Gweler yr Adran Geffylau yn y Rhaglen yma ar gyfer y rheoliadau yn yr adran geffylau.
12. Ni ddeilir y Pwyllgor, Swyddogion, beirniaid na Stiwardiaid yn gyfrifol am unrhyw ddiffrod, niwed neu golled i wylwyr neu unrhyw beson arall a fydd a y cae ar ddiwrnod y Sioe, wath sut y cyflawnwyd y ddiffrod, niwed neu golled.
13. Yn ogystal, ni dderbynnir cyfrifoldeb am golled na difrod i foddyr, prun ai yn cyrraedd, gadael neu wedi ei barcio ar y cae Sioe nau'r maes parcio.
14. Pe bai cyfanswm y derbyniadau yn llai na chydfanswm y treuliau, bydd hawlgab y Pwyllgor i dynnu cyfran gyfartal, neu gymeryd gwobr yn gyfan er mwyn gwneud yn iawn am y golled.
15. Bydd yn rhaid i bob arddangosia yn yr Adran Wartheg gael passport cyfrediol neu ddogfen adnabod i'w gyflwyno i'r Ysgrifennydd Adran ar y diwrnod er mwyn gallu hysbysu BCMS o'r symudiad i'r Sioe ac oddi yna.
16. Bydd rhaid i bob arddangoswyr yn yr adran Ddefaid lenwi ffurflenni symud pwrpasol gan yr Adran Safonau masnach er mwyn dod ar y cae, ac un arall er mwyn symud y stoc oddi ar y cae. Mae hyn hefyd yn berthnasol i eifr. Dylai pob anifail sydd a sicrwydd MV gael tystysgrif gyfredol er mwyn gallu arddangos yn yr adran MV.
17. Bydd rhaid i bob ymgeisydd yn yr adran dofednod gyflwyno rhif CPH sef "holding number" a gofnodir a chaniatai i'w stoc gael eu archwilio gan filfeddyg cyn cael mynediad i'r babel dofednod.
18. Disgwylir i bob cerbyd a gaiff fynediad i'r adrannau da byw gydymffurfio a rheolau glanweithdra.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Society shall be known as the "Lley and Eifonydd Agricultural Show and Canine Society". Its objects shall be the promotion of good stock and the encouragement of all branches of Agriculture.
2. The Society shall consist of Honorary Officials, a Committee of Management and Members. The Minimum membership fee shall be £5 per annum, the fee being considered due and payable on the 1st October of each year. Privileges of members are as follows:-
 - a) Members badge
 - b) Reduced entry fees in such sections as shown in the price list
 - c) Participation in determining the Policy of the Society at the Annual general meeting
 - d) Entitlements to copies of the Society's publications e.g schedule of classes and prizes and the annual report.Vice President's fee - £10, one badge and one complimentary ticket
3. All exhibits in the livestock section must be the property of the exhibitor. The Committee shall have the right to call upon any exhibitor to prove such ownership. Infringement of this rule will entail forfeiture of all prizes at the Show in which the rule shall have been infringed, and it may also entail barring from future Shows held by the Committee. Neither the Committee nor any official or judge shall be held liable in respect of any statement made in pursuance of this rule, or in any attempt to enforce it.
4. All exhibits in whatever Section or Class will be considered as being in the sole charge of the exhibitor. Neither the Committee nor any official, Judge or Steward acting for and on behalf of the Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury caused by or to any exhibit whether owing to an accident, negligence or any other cause.
5. All Judges shall be appointed by the Committee and their decision shall be final in all cases. Any judge may withhold any prize if, in his/her opinion, the exhibit does not attain the required standard of merit, and in the event of the entries in any class in which the total number of entries is less than the total number of prizes being offered, the first prize money will be withheld, unless specifically recommended by the Judge. The judges shall determine their awards solely by reference to the numbers affixed to each exhibit and correspondingly with the number printed in the catalogue. Only the signed award of the Judges shall be accepted by the Show Committee as evidence that a prize has been awarded.
6. No person other than the Judges, Stewards, officials and persons in charge of stock shall be allowed in the judging ring, and no person shall act as steward in any calls in which he/she is an exhibitor. Any person interfering with any judge shall be removed from the showground, and if that person is an exhibitor, shall forfeit any prizes due to him/her.
7. All entries must be in the hands of the Secretaries by:-

Horse Section	12 th April 2024
Showjumping section	1 st May 2024
Cookery and handicraft section	1 st May 2024
All other sections	1 st May 2024

All entries must be on the official forms and accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.

Cheques and postal orders must be made payable to the "Lleyn & Eifonydd Agricultural Society" BACS details available from the secretaries.

8. All exhibitors in the livestock sections must be on the Showground at least 30 minutes before judging is due to commence. All exhibits must remain on the Showground until 3.30pm. All entries in the fur and feather, cookery and handicraft section must be gaged or staged by 9.30am and must not be removed until 3.30pm.
9. All protests and complaints must be delivered in writing to the Show Secretary one hour before the closure of the Show, together with a deposit of £30. Such objections will be considered by the judges and/or officials before the close of the Show. If any objections or complaints remain unsettled, it shall be settled by the Committee at their next meeting. If any complaint or objection is disallowed, the deposit shall be forfeited.
10. The winner of each perpetual cup shall be responsible for returning it to the Committee at least 11 months after the last Show, and shall give a written undertaking to that effect.
11. One person in charge of an exhibit or set of exhibits in the cattle and sheep section shall be allowed in without charge, and a further one complimentary ticket will be allocated for every four exhibits in the sheep section. In the other sections, with the exception of the dogs and horses, an entry fee of £2 will entitle the exhibitor to one free admission ticket. Dog exhibitors pay entries on the day. For horse entries – please see the Equine Section of the Schedule.
12. The Committee, or any official, judge or steward shall not be held liable for any loss, damage or injury to any spectator or any other person being on the showground on the day of the Show, however such damage, loss or injury shall have been caused.
13. Similarly, no responsibility is accepted by the Committee for any loss or damage while entering or leaving the showground or public car park or when parked either on the Showground or public car park.
14. Should the total receipts be less than the total expenditure, the Committee shall have the power to deduct a proportionate percentage for, or to remit the whole of the prize money, sufficient to make up the deficit.
15. Each entry in the cattle section must be accompanied by a current passport or COR document to be presented to the section Secretary on arrival to allow notification of movement to the BCMS.
16. Each exhibitor in the sheep section must complete the correct movement license to be allowed onto the showground, and complete a return journey license which is required by Trading Standards. This also applies to goats. All MV accredited exhibits must be accompanied by a valid MV certificate to be allowed to exhibit in the MV section.
17. Each exhibitor in the poultry section must have a valid CPH number which will be recorded and must allow a Veterinary Surgeon to inspect all entries before they are allowed into the poultry marquee.
18. All vehicles admitted onto the showground must comply with hygiene regulations.

DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at kennel Club licensed events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle does not have air conditioning, seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible and plenty of stops should be taken with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure our dog is not sitting in direct sunlight. There should be plenty of air circulating around the dog

When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle

Keep your dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water to drink so your dog is always hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary excretion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time

Remember, if you feel hot, your dog is likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

Warning:- if your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without any liability for any damage caused.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a kennel Club licensed event should take reasonable steps to ensure the needs of the dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Regulations.

C CATTLE SECTION

For all Exhibits, the name of the breeder, name of the animal, its date of birth and her book reference and name of dam and reference must be included on entry forms. All entries are subject to the following conditions under the Brucellosis (England and Wales) order 1981 (as amended)

1. The premises to be used for accredited cattle must be cleared of stock and cleansed and disinfected before the day of use.
2. The isolation accommodation must be clearly marked
3. When sterilised milking units are provided at the show, they must be suitable disinfected after milking each cow. If hand milking is practised the milker must disinfect his/her hands after milking each cow. Water and milking points should be clearly marked
4. Only milk re-constituted from dried milk (as defined in article 10(5) of the Transit of animals (Road and rail Order 1975) may be fed to calves, but a dam may be allowed to suckle her calf
5. Animals who calve or show evidence of calving whilst at eh showground must be placed in isolation accommodation pending their possible early removal form the showground
6. Where an animal calves at full term, and the owner arranges for a blood sample and a vaginal swab to be taken and examined at an approved laboratory, and the Rose Bengal Test (RBPT) and microscopic examination of a smear made from the vaginal swab are negative, the animal may return to the show lines at the discretion of the Show Secretary
7. Where the animal calves prematurely or aborts the D.V.O must be informed immediately. Th animal must be returned home together with all other show animals form the same registered premises after a full range of samples (including fi at all possible a placental smear) has been taken. The suspected animal must be isolated during transit.
8. No person (other than show officials, judges, marshals and the owner or his/her representative) shall be permitted to enter the show ring during the period the animals are paraded.
9. Judges must wash and dry their hands before handling accredited stock in the show ring and an adequate supply of clean water, disinfectant, soap and disposable towels should be provided for this purpose.

10. The show organisers shall be responsible for complying with the above conditions
11. "Preferably, no cattle are to be exhibited if infected with warble fly". A condition of entry that they must be accompanied by a Certificate of Treatment will be strictly enforced.

Conditions for the approval of shows which provide separate sections for Accredited and top-supervised (S2) * scheme sheep.

A plan must be submitted to the local DVO with the proposed separate section for Accredited sheep clearly marked in red and the section for Top-supervised (S2) marked in green

There must be satisfactory separation of each category of Scheme sheep. If the premises are large, it may be possible to have the approved section separated by a solid partition from the floor to the roof. If this cannot be done, a stock free area of 10 metres must be maintained between each category i.e. between Accredited, Top- Supervised and Non-Scheme sheep. In open penning, at least 10 metres separation is required between each category of sheep in pens. At loading bays and in passages there must be at least 2 metres between different categories while sheep are moving.

M/V Scheme sheep must have a separate loading and unloading point which should be shown on the plan and their movement into, within and out of the show must be in accordance with the routes marked on the plan. Where passages to other sections exist, these should be sealed off by secure barriers.

If scheme and non-scheme sheep are to be judged in the same class, the ring should be split to ensure adequate separation. Preferable scheme sheep should be led by a halter or collar and should be 2 metre space between different categories. It is accepted that judges will need to pass between and handle different categories of sheep but any examination such as mouthing should be carried out by the handler for the judge's inspection.

M/V scheme sheep must at no time be allowed to come into contact with non-scheme sheep or sheep of a lower status. Accredited and top-supervised (S2) sheep must not be transported to or from shows together. Nor must they share transport with lower status or non-scheme.

There must be separate watering and feeding facilities for each category of scheme sheep

In order to gain admission to the designated approved section of the show, all scheme sheep must be accompanied by proof of status. Accredited sheep must have a yellow MV20B certificate and top-supervised (S2) sheep, a blue MV20A certificate. Sheep with a red MV 20 certificate are not eligible for entry to the approved section and must be classed as non-scheme sheep.

Show authorities shall be responsible for complying with the conditions.

REMINDER: show organisers are reminded that land to be used as a showground should be cleared of non-scheme sheep at least 30 days prior to moving on of scheme sheep.

The exhibition of sheep and goats from premises registered on the temporary Scrapie Export register, or are members of Category IV of the Sheep and Goat health Scheme must be segregated under the rules of the above scheme. Approval must be obtained from the

Divisional veterinary officer. Unproved land must not have been used on animals other than form registered premises for the previous 12 weeks. Segregation of sheep on the Scrapie export register or those monitored as Category IV of the Sheep and Goat Health Scheme is required if pregnant or recently lambed sheep are present at the same show.
